Purpose:

This course provides training and resources for personnel who require advanced application of the Incident Command System (ICS).

Who Should Attend:

The target audience for this course includes senior personnel who are expected to perform in a management capacity at an incident or event. This includes individuals who may serve as Incident Commander or as members of the Command or General Staff, Area Command, or Multi-Agency Coordination Group/Emergency Operations Center (EOC) management. This course expands upon information covered in the ICS-100 through ICS-300 courses.

These earlier courses (ICS-100, ICS-200 & ICS-300) are prerequisites for ICS-400.

The course objectives are as follows:

- Explain how major incidents pose special management challenges.
- Describe the circumstances in which an Area Command is established.
- Describe the circumstances in which Multiagency Coordination Systems are established.
- Use ICS to manage an incident or event.
